PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The United Macedonian-Americans of Detroit (UMAD) Scholarship will award two (2) qualified high school or undergraduate university students in the Metro Detroit region and two (2) qualified high school or undergraduate university students from the Republic of Macedonia with \$1000 scholarships for full-time undergraduate studies at accredited colleges and universities in either the United States or the Republic of Macedonia.

REQUIRMENTS & ELIGIBILITY

- 500-word essay responding to the question, "What makes you a proud Macedonian or Macedonian-American?"
- Fill out attached application and provide additional documents requested
- Students of Macedonian descent with min. 3.0 grade point average (GPA) attending high school, university/college
- Must provide one (1) copy of most recent transcript from high school or college
- One recent photo of applicant (may be reprinted on UMAD materials)

*ONLY ONE MEMBER PER IMMEDIATE FAMILY, PER GIVEN ACADEMIC YEAR

SELECTION CRITERIA

- 1. Compelling nature of their essay
- 2. Academic achievements and extracurricular activities to date
- 3. Interest in Macedonian subjects and involvement in Macedonian Community
